Cervical Screening

We are pleased to announce that our cervical screening targets were the highest at 84% within South Reading CCG. This is due to the hard work & commitment of all staff and our robust recall protocol. All women who are registered at our practice are invited for cervical screening:

aged 25 to 49 - every three years

aged 50 to 64 - every five years

over 65 - only women who haven't been screened since age 50 or those who have recently had abnormal tests
